DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE AND BENEFICIARIES OF THE PROJECT:

The proposed project is an ordinance amending Chapter 1 (General Enforcement) and Chapter 26 (Zoning Code) to consolidate enforcement provisions, amend certain civil penalties, add an environmental restoration remedy, align the violation correction period with state law, and make other minor and clarifying changes.

EXEMPT STATUS:

Categorical Exemption(s). CEQA Guidelines Section 15321 (Enforcement Actions by Regulatory Agencies) and Section 15061(b)(3) (Common Sense)

REASON WHY THIS PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The proposed project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the CEQA Guidelines pursuant to the Provisions of Title 14 of the California Administrative Code, Section 15321 (Class 21) as an action to enforce violations of county code, ordinances, or other requirements and permits or approvals issued by the county, and pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) (Common Sense) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that adoption of this ordinance to improve ongoing enforcement efforts may have a significant effect on the environment.
