Project Title: Reclamation District 1001 Auxiliary Drainage Pump Station (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SUT-16708-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located along the Natomas Cross Canal North Levee at the south end of the Reclamation District (RD) 1001 Lateral 4 Channel, Sutter County

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SUT-16708-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, RD-1001.

RD-1001 proposes to construct a new fuel-powered auxiliary drainage pump station along the Natomas Cross Canal North Levee to minimize flood risk due to loss of power at the two existing pump stations.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
