Project Title: County Road 40 Over Cache Creek Bridge (22C-0091) Replacement Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. YOL-13621-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located on County Road (CR) 40 where it crosses Cache Creek and is within the Cache Creek Canyon Regional Park, in the County of Yolo, State of California; Latitude 38.90991, Longitude -122.30851.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number YOL-13621-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Yolo County Department of Community Services.

The project is limited to the replacement of an existing structurally deficient bridge (22C-0091) located on CR 40 over Cache Creek with a new three-span, cast-in-place, reinforced concrete slab superstructure supported on two-column pile extension bents and seat type abutments founded on 30-inch cast-in-drilled-hole concrete piles. The new bridge will be constructed on an improved alignment at essentially the same location as the existing bridge.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
