Project Title: Clear Creek Clean-Out at Hidden Valley Rd. (EPIMS Notification No. BUT-13028-R2)

Project Location: The project is located in Clear Creek between Hidden Valley Road and Clear Creek Cemetery Road in Butte Valley, County of Butte, State of California; Latitude 39.66748, Longitude - 121.62420; Section 22, Township 21N, Range 3E of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quadrangle map Cherokee.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has extended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number BUT-13028-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Alia Robbins.

Routine maintenance work, as described in this Agreement includes the following: removing debris, vegetation, rubbish, downed trees, and other material that could obstruct the natural flow; controlling weeds, grasses, emergent vegetation, and woody vegetation; repairing and maintaining culverts, bridges, and small structures; making repairs to control erosion and stabilize banks; and other work necessary to maintain the functional and structural integrity of waterways.

Exempt Status:

- Categorical Exemption. Type – Class (1 and 4); California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections (15301 and 15304)

Reasons why project is exempt: The project falls under a Class 1 Categorical Exemption because it consists of the maintenance and repair of a topographical feature involving no expansion of existing use and function. The project falls under a Class 4 Categorical Exemption because it consists of minor private alterations in the condition of land, water, and vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees.
