The proposed project will provide a new Sheriff and CalFire co-located essential services emergency dispatch facility in San Luis Obispo County (project). The project includes an approximately 20,000 square foot building that will include offices and facilities suitable for 24-hour staffing. The project will require the extension of existing utilities on the parcel to serve the facility. Site improvements will also include a 140' tall 4-leg communications tower, parking lot(s), secure fencing installation, a covered structure for CalFire Mobile Command Vehicle, perimeter security fence, stormwater features, landscaping and sidewalks.
