Project Description:

The Department of Food and Agriculture, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, is seeking to approve a Cannabis Cultivation License submitted on February 10, 2020, by Neil Richardson.

Project Activities:

The Project will consist of 2,870 square feet of canopy area, 861 square feet of immature plant area with processing, packaging, and distribution areas onsite. The project site is located at a preexisting commercial building with no indication of expansion. Slight modifications to existing areas on site will occur – existing parking area and sidewalk revamp, existing fencing and gate revamp, and existing landscape renovation.
