The proposed amendments will take effect in 2023, continuing controls of vessels covered under the existing regulation, plus will expand requirements to other vessel types. The proposed amendments will also: (1) establish expanded and more stringent requirements for engines operating on harbor craft, and (2) add mandates to accelerate deployment of zero-emission and advanced technologies into the marine harbor craft sector.
