Project Title: 6847 Lucas Valley Road Bridge Replacement Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0024-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at Nicasio Creek, 6847 Lucas Valley Road, Nicasio, CA 94946, in the County of Marin.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0024-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Mark Roos.

The project will remove an old railcar bridge, replace it with a new free-spanning steel bridge, and stabilize the right bank of Nicasio Creek upstream of the bridge with rock riprap.
