Project Title: Coastal Haven Water Diversion (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0431-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at Pogonip Creek, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Latitude 36.9887391, Longitude -122.0365712 or Section 12, Township 11S, Range 2W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Santa Cruz, or 335 Golf Club Drive, Santa Cruz, CA 95060; Assessor's Parcel Number 001-172-04.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0431-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Coastal Haven Families LLC as represented by Philippe Habib.

The proposed project is limited to the diversion of water from Pogonip Creek to irrigate 4.2-acres of agricultural land. The proposed project will use a 50 gallon per minute pump to divert approximately 6.5-acre feet of water per year from Pogonip Creek. Minor sediment and debris clearing, by using shovels or other hand tools, may occur to clean the water intake and screen.
