Project Title: Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0244-R2, "Feather River Meadows"
Nonindustrial Timber Management Plan (NTMP) 2-99NTMP-006-PLU

Project Location: The projects are located within the boundaries of a NTMP on Rice Creek and two unnamed Class II watercourses that flow to Rice Creek, which is tributary to the North Fork Feather River, in Plumas County, State of California. The projects are located on the Child Meadows U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map, Township 29N, Range 5E, Sections 19, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The projects are limited to the removal of a culvert, the reshaping and addition of angular rock at each approach at crossing #24 and #25 and the installation of a culvert and water drafting site at crossing #23. Further information can be found in 2-99NTMP-006-PLU.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
