Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The project includes a resource management permit and grading permit to remediate grading and construction completed without the benefit of permits. The proposed project includes the removal of four footbridges, three tent platforms, and relocation of a driveway. The project also includes the legalization of a man-made pond. The proposed grading remediation includes 3,680 cubic yards of earthwork (1,840 cubic yards of cut and 1,840 cubic yards of fill).

The proposed remediation work has the potential to result in significant effects to air quality and biological resources associated with the proposed earthwork and demolition. Mitigation Measures include best management practices for grading activities to ensure potential impacts are less than significant. The Mitigation Measures also require that a qualified biologist conduct pre-construction surveys, education sessions to construction personnel, and confer with California Fish and Wildlife staff in the even resources are encountered.
