Subject: Notice of an Appeal Filed and Stay on the Effectiveness of the Environmental Determination for the World Oil Tank Installation Project – State Clearinghouse #2020100119

To Whom It May Concern:

As the lead agency pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, the Port of Long Beach (Port) hereby provides notice that on October 4, 2024, an appeal was filed on the Long Beach Board of Harbor Commissioners' September 23, 2024 certification of the Final Environmental Impact Report for the World Oil Tank Installation Project, State Clearinghouse #2020100119 (Project).

In accordance with Long Beach Municipal Code Section 21.21.507(F), the filing of an appeal will stay the effect of: (1) the environmental determination; (2) any project approval made pursuant to the environmental determination; and (3) any notice of determination until the Long Beach City Council renders a decision on the appeal. The Port filed the Notice of Determination with the State Clearinghouse and Los Angeles County Clerk on September 24, 2024.

If the Long Beach City Council denies the appeal for the Project, an amended Notice of Determination will be filed accordingly with the State Clearinghouse and Los Angeles County Clerk. If the Long Beach City Council grants the appeal, the Notice of Determination for the Project will be withdrawn.
