Title: Sacramento River Erosion Control and Habitat Enhancement Project

Proponent: Brannan-Andrus Levee Maintenance District

Location: Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel 157-0231-020, near Isleton, Sacramento County.

Description: The Brannan-Andrus Levee Maintenance District is proposing to resolve erosion issues on the left bank of the Sacramento River, on Brannan Island, at approximate River Miles (RM) 14.60 to 15.18, 16.36 to 17.00 and 17.13 to 17.34. Once completed, the project would provide suitable levee erosion control on approximately 1.2 NM of levee; provide fish-friendly habitat through the creation of wetland and riparian benches on the Sacramento River channel margin; and minimize long-term maintenance and repair costs by repairing existing areas of erosion using stable and effective erosion control methodologies. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 10-year General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use through June 22, 2032, for a dock relocation that is required for the Project.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as  Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on June 23, 2022, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project  will  will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A  Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures  were  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was or  was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations  was  was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings  were  were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, Brannan-Andrus Levee Maintenance District (District), adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Mitigation, Monitoring, and Reporting Program and approved the project on December 10, 2020. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND as prepared for this project by District and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating the District's document. The MND and the record of project approval may be examined at the above shown California State Lands Commission Sacramento office address.
