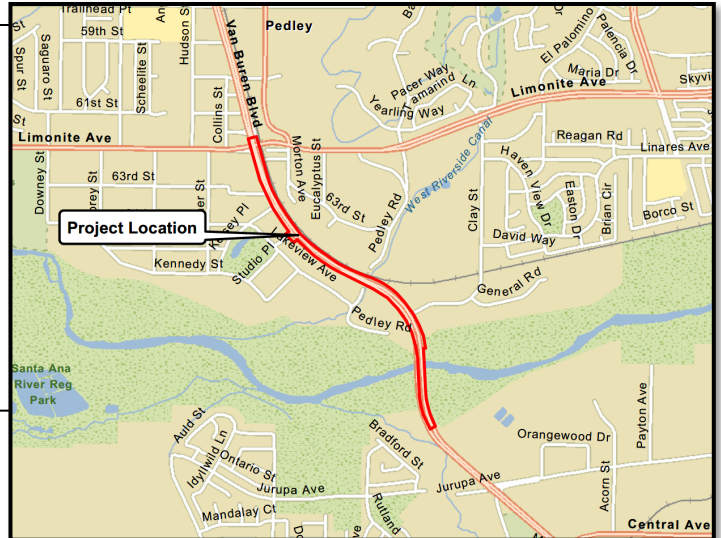
Notice of Availability of Initial Study Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration Opportunity for Public Hearing for the Van Buren Boulevard Widening Project

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The City of Jurupa Valley proposes to widen Van Buren Boulevard to provide six (6) total lanes, three (3) in each direction while maintaining the existing raised center median and providing curb and gutter. The widening of pavement along Van Buren Boulevard begins approximately 700 feet south of Limonite Avenue, and ends approximately 600 feet north of Clay Street, where the existing pavement is already wide enough to accommodate the third lane. The Project will restripe the already widened area to provide a third lane in each direction from Clay Street across existing bridge over the Santa Ana River.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

The City of Jurupa Valley has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. The studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains the findings of the studies is the Initial Study with proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration for this project. This notice is to advise you that the preparation of this report has been completed and is available for you to read. Currently no public hearing is scheduled, however, if you have concerns you would like to address in a public hearing, please request a public hearing no later than November 23, 2020. With this notice, your comments are requested, also before the deadline of November 23, 2020.
