PROJECT TITLE: Sherry Barn Roof Replacement

LOCATION: Jack London State Historic Park ([Sherry Barn](#)) **COUNTY:** Sonoma

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Replace the damaged roof of the Sherry Barn in Jack London State Historic Park to help protect and preserve the resource following damaged caused by a wind event. Work will:

- Remove the existing damaged metal panels;
- Replace damaged cross members in-kind as needed by screwing to existing rafters;
- Install new metal panels made from corten steel, attached with galvanized roofing screws;
- Seal the seams of the roof with caulking; and
- Repair and re-attach one piece of damaged fascia trim.
