Project Title: Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement, Notification No. 1600-2020-0184-R1, City of Point Arena, Arena Cove Parking Lot Repair

Project Location: The project is located at 810 Port Road within the city limits of the City of Point Arena, County of Mendocino, California. The project area is located within the United States Geological Survey (USGS) Point Arena 7.5-minute Quadrangle (USGS, 2020); Township 12 north, Range 17 east, Section 11, Mount Diablo Meridian. The Assessor's parcel number (APN) is 027-041-41-0.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0184-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Richard Shoemaker representing the City of Point Arena. The project is limited to one encroachment to repair the Arena Cove parking lot, seawall, flanking jetty rock, and adjacent rock cobble shoulder that were damaged in a storm on January 15, 2016.

Person or Public Agency Carrying Out Project: Richard Shoemaker, City Manager, representing the City of Point Arena.

Reasons why project is exempt: The project replaces a culvert with a culvert that is correctly sized, placed, and aligned. There would be no significant adverse impact on endangered, rare or threatened species or their habitat pursuant to section 15065. There are no hazardous materials at or around the project site that may be disturbed or removed. The project will not result in impacts that are significant when viewed in connection with the effects of past projects, the effects of other current projects, and the effects of probable future projects.
