Project Title: Point of Delivery (POD) amendment time extension between Zone 7 Water Agency (Zone 7) and Kern County Water Agency (KCWA) for the Zone 7-Cawelo Water Banking and Exchange Program

Project Location – Specific: State Water Project (SWP) facilities and the Zone 7 intake and delivery systems.

Project Location – City: Dublin, Livermore, Pleasanton

Project Location – County: Alameda County

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: It is the intent of the parties to do a 10-year time extension for an existing Point of Delivery (POD) agreement (#06010) between Zone 7 Water Agency and Cawelo Water District (Cawelo; a member unit of Kern County Water Agency) consistent with the guidelines communicated by the Department of Water Resources (DWR) which allow Zone 7 to send water to the Cawelo water storage bank for storage and recover it. There will be no construction as part of this Project, but rather this will result in continuation of currently permitted activity. The Project consists of a time extension to allow Zone 7 to continue sending water to Cawelo for storage up to 2030. Recovery of water must occur by 2035 per the agreement.

Name of Public Agency Approving and Carrying Out Project: The amendment for extension of time will be signed by Zone 7, KCWA, Department of Water Resources (DWR) and State Water Project Analysis Office (SWAPO).
