Project Title: Kenefick Road Flood Control Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SJN-14289-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at 27102 N. Kenefick Road where it crosses an unnamed tributary to Dry Creek, County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 38.23447, Longitude -121.24512; Section 32, Township 05N, Range 07E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Lockeford, Mount Diablo Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-14289-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, San Joaquin County Department of Public Works.

The Project is limited to the reconstruction of a 285-foot segment of Kenefick Road. The road crosses an unnamed tributary to Dry Creek and was damaged during heavy storm activity in 2017. Road reconstruction activities will include the replacement of three corrugated metal pipes with three reinforced concrete box culverts which will facilitate the conveyance of high flows in the event of a subsequent heavy storm event.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
