PROJECT TITLE: Remove Soil Cement Footprint and Replace w/ Decomposed Granite

LOCATION: State Indian Museum [38°34'22.6"N 121°28'18.2"W](#) **COUNTY:** Sacramento

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Removal and replacement of soil cement located behind the State Indian Museum. The soil cement is a remnant of a structure that was dismantled in 2019. The project footprint consists of a 30-foot diameter with four (4) inch depth and has seventeen (17) cement post footings that measure eighteen (18) inches by eighteen (18) inches. Work will:

- Remove seventeen (17) cement post footings and refill the holes with decomposed granite;
- Remove a cement block with handprints, refill the hole with decomposed granite: block will be saved
- Dismantle and remove exposed electrical outlet;
- Remove landscape plantings and markers surrounding border of footprint;
- Break-up the soil cement by hand using pickaxes and shovels, and dispose of;
- Cap the footprint with decomposed granite and use electrical compacter to create a stable and more level surface;
- Grade and level the area to the south of the footprint approximately four (4) inches.


REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:
