Subject: Filing of Notice of Determination in compliance with Section 21152 of the Public Resource Code

Project: Environmental Impact Report No. 7869, Unclassified Conditional Use Permit No. 3677 (State Clearinghouse No. 2020110008).

Location: The subject parcel is located in western Fresno County, generally bounded by State Route 33 (SR 33 also known as S. Derrick Avenue) to the west, West Manning Avenue to the south, S. Merced Avenue to the east, and W. Adams Avenue to the north, W. South Avenue bisects the site from east to west, approximately 7 miles west of the unincorporated community of Tranquillity. (Sup. Dist. 1) County of Fresno.

Sponsor: EDPR CA SOLAR PARK VI LLC

Description: The Sonrisa Solar Project consists of the construction, operation, maintenance, and decommissioning an approximately 200-megawatt alternating current (MWac) solar photovoltaic (PV) energy generation facility, 184 MWac energy storage system, and related facilities and infrastructure, known as the Sonrisa Solar Project. The Project would extend (by approximately 0.2 mile) and share use of an existing 3.3-mile long 230 kilovolt (kV) transmission line to PG&E's existing Tranquillity Switching Station. In addition to the shared use of the transmission line and switching station, the Project would share other facilities with Scarlet Solar, including an electrical substation and operation and maintenance building. The Project is expected to be decommissioned after a 35-year permit term.

This is to advise that the County of Fresno (Lead Agency Responsible Agency) has approved the above-described project on February 11, 2025, and has made the following determination:

- The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
