Project Title: Interstate 40 Bridge Scour Mitigation, Environmental Permit Information Management System (EPIMS) EPIMS-SBR-24898-R6.

Project Location (include county): The project is located on Interstate 40 (I-40) at Post Mile (PM) 101.33, in the County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude 34.803184, Longitude -115.292256; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 0655-061-09-0000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS-SBR-24898-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation District 8. The Project will remove .42 acres of existing rock slope protection (RSP), relace both bridges at PM 101.33, and place fully grouted RSP around the abutments.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 03/4/2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
