Project Title: Lake Machado Ecosystems Resource Management Maintenance Project, Phase 1 (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0072-R5)

Project Location (include county): The project is located Ken Malloy Regional Park within Lake Machado and the marsh areas below Lake Machado in the city of Los Angeles, in the county of Los Angeles; Latitude 33.790823, Longitude -118.285811; Nearest address, South Vermont Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90710.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0072-R5, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks.

This project will consist of emergent wetland removal consisting of bulrush marsh and built up brush that has overgrown in certain areas around Lake Machado and the marsh areas to the south of Lake Machado. The removed vegetation will be dried out in an upland area of the park and hauled offsite.
