

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED
NEGATIVE DECLARATION
FOR
SPORTS PARK DRIVE PEDESTRIAN OVERCROSSING PROJECT**

The City of Woodland has completed an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for a proposed pedestrian path from the intersection of Matmor Road and Sports Park Drive, crossing over SR-113, and connecting to a planned 8-acre park and Harry Lorenzo Avenue east of the project site. The IS/MND found the following environmental factors to be less than significant with mitigation incorporated: Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Geology and Seismicity, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Noise, Traffic and Circulation, and Water Quality.

The project is a linear project crossing over SR-113 from the cross streets of Matmor Road and Sports Park Drive in the west to Harry Lorenzo Avenue in the east in the City of Woodland, California.

Based on a search of the California Department of Toxic Substance Control's EnviroStar database, the State Water Resources Control Board's Geotracker database, and CalEPA's Cortese List website, there are no hazardous waste cleanup sites within the project site.

The City proposes to develop a pedestrian path from the intersection of Matmor Road and Sports Park Drive, cross over SR-113, and connect to a planned 2-acre park currently under construction. The pedestrian path will connect new and planned development on the east side of SR-113 with a school, a sports park and existing residential facilities on the west side of SR-113.
