Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Project addresses 1,2,3-TCP contamination of the Front Street well by the construction of treatment improvements on the District-owned well site. The Project consists of the installation of a granular activated carbon (GAC) treatment system. The Project is located at the southwest end of the unincorporated community of Earlimart. Surrounding land uses include residential, agricultural, highway and railroad.

The evaluations conducted in support of the Proposed Project's Initial Study did not identify any significant or potentially significant effects that would result from the completion of the Project. The District's Biological Evaluation Report (Report) recommended that potential impacts to nesting birds could be reduced to a less than significant level through the incorporation of the following mitigation practices: scheduling of construction during low risk times of year, preconstruction surveys and avoidance of active nests. Preventive measures will be incorporated into construction documents to avoid potential impacts.
