Notice of Availability/Notice of Intent Initial Study to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for City of Lathrop Harlan Road Realignment at Roth Road Project

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

Future development projects within San Joaquin County, Manteca, and Lathrop will cause the Interstate (I-5) Interchange to operate at an unacceptable level at Roth Road. To improve traffic operations, the City of Lathrop is proposing to shift easterly the intersection of Harlan Road and Roth Road. This Harlan Road Realignment at Roth Road Project will allow more spacing on Roth Rd between I-5 / Roth Road termini intersection and Harlan Road. The City of Lathrop is currently evaluating three alternatives to improve the realignment on Harlan Rd north of Roth Road.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

The City has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. The studies within the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration show it would not significantly affect the quality of the environment. This notice is to advise you that the preparation of this report has been completed and is available for you to review.

WHAT'S AVAILABLE?

An Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared and is available for public review beginning Wednesday, November 25th, 2020 through December 31st, 2020.
