DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Issue a right-of-entry (ROE) permit to PG&E for completion of Order Number 35182220 Clayton 2212 OH Pole & Anchor Replacement project within Mount Diablo State Park. PG&E proposes replacing one distribution pole (new hole), one anchor (expansion), and one down guy along the CLAYTON 2212 distribution line, located roughly 1.7 miles southwest of Clayton, in Contra Costa County.

All work conducted in association with the ROE permit will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code.
