Project Title: Mirada Road Pedestrian Bridge Replacement and Bank Stabilization Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0190-R3).

Project Location (include county): The Project is located at the pedestrian bridge over the Arroyo de en Medio in the County of San Mateo (Latitude 37.49336 Longitude -122.45990).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0310-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, San Mateo County Department of Public Works.

The Project includes stabilization of an eroding bluff that experienced extensive erosion during the 2015/2016 and 2016/2017 rainy seasons. Over the course of two phases, the County will install a shotcrete wall supported by tie back anchors and rock slope protection and replace the bridge over the Arroyo de en Medio with a new aluminum bridge.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on July 13, 2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
