PROJECT TITLE: Franklin Community Septic Conversion Project (Project)

PROJECT LOCATION: Franklin Boulevard, Hood-Franklin Road, Bilby Way, Kenneth Way, Willard Parkway, and Dennis Way in the community of Franklin, Sacramento County.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project. The Project includes abandoning private septic systems and connecting 50 existing parcels to a public sewer line within the community of Franklin in Sacramento County, California. The Project includes installation of a low-pressure system with a single individual grinder pump located at each parcel, and construction of a new three-inch low-pressure force main sewer line on Franklin Boulevard, Hood-Franklin Road, Bilby Way, Kenneth Way, and Dennis Way that will carry the flow to a new connection at manhole 258-158-1001 at Willard Parkway.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on July 3, 2024. The Sacramento Area Sewer District will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have significant water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted for the Project.

5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the Project.
6. Findings were made pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15091.
