**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Littlejohns Creek, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37.920069, Longitude -121.211043 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees).

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-32099-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Greenlaw Development, LLC as represented by Robert Mitchell.

The project includes the re-alignment, excavation, filling, and grading of an unnamed tributary to Littlejohns creek as part of a phased, 8-acre project.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
