**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at North Littlejohns Creek, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37.915731, Longitude -121.210538 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Numbers 179-220-54 and 179-220-50.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-36256-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Greenlaw Development, LLC., as represented by Robert Mitchell.

The project is limited to the installation of storm drains and a storm drain outfall structure on North Littlejohns Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
