Project Description: The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 7, in cooperation with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) and the Gateway Cities Council of Governments, has completed the Initial Study (IS) with Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND)/Environmental Assessment (EA) with Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the Eastbound (EB) State Route 91/Atlantic Avenue to Cherry Avenue Auxiliary Lane Improvements Project. The IS/EA identifies the Build Alternative as the Preferred Alternative. The Build Alternative would develop and implement an 0.86-mile auxiliary lane on EB State Route 91 (SR-91) within a 1.4-mile segment from the southbound Interstate 710 (I-710) interchange connector to EB SR-91, to Cherry Avenue. This alternative would also include improvements to the Atlantic Avenue on-ramp and Cherry Avenue off-ramp.

This is to advise you that a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) has been made for this project by the California Department of Transportation as assigned by the Federal Highway Administration pursuant to 23 USC 327.
