Project Title: Major Amendment 1 for Vallejo Mobile Estate Routine Maintenance (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0296-R3)

Project Location (include county): The routine maintenance project is located on the "Lemon Street Channel" at 285 Lincoln Road West in Vallejo, Solano County, California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Major Amendment 1 for Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2017-0296-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Vallejo Mobile Estates, LLC.

The major amendment includes 1) increasing the amount of vegetation removal from 1,500 feet to 2,500 feet annually, and 2) allowing the use of herbicides to control invasive cattails and tules in the channel.
