Project Title: Upper Mormon Slough Erosion Repair (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SJN-18018-R2)

Project Location: The Project is located on the north and south banks of Mormon Slough in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 38.049425, Longitude -121.014312; Section 5, Township 02N, Range 09E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Linden, Mount Diablo Meridian.

Project Description: The Project is limited to channel grading and slope protection along the banks of the Upper Mormon Slough corridor. The activities consist of grubbing, clearing, and grading the banks in order to place rock slope protection (RSP) along approximately 0.63 mile of the north bank and approximately 0.23 mile of the south bank. The layer of the RSP being placed in the channel banks would be a minimum of 18 inches. Following the RSP placement, an 8-inch layer of thick gravel filter will be placed by hand on the channel banks to prevent erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
