
Project Description: Upper Lacey Meadow Restoration (WCB Project ID: 2021020). The Upper Lacey Meadow Restoration Project is an implementation project designed to restore meadow habitat and hydrologic function and enhance stream flow. Lacey Creek would be returned from its current alignment through the forest back to the meadow where moderate to high flows would be directed into multiple historic channels. Channel abandonment would be accomplished through placement of channel fill in select locations.
