**Project Location** (include county): The Program is located at nine parks in the east San Fernando Valley along State Route 170. These parks include David M. Gonzales Recreation Center, Fernangeles Park, Strathern Park North, Whitsett Fields Park North, Valley Plaza Park North, Valley Plaza Park South, Alexandria Park, North Hollywood Park, and Valley Village Park in the City of Los Angeles in Los Angeles County.

**Project Description:** The Program includes construction of stormwater capture facilities at nine parks to help capture surface flow and divert stormwater runoff from the Tujunga Wash Central Branch storm drain to recharge the groundwater basin. Underground infiltration galleries would be constructed within open space portions of each of the nine parks, and other appurtenances would be installed to connect to and manage flow from existing storm drains.
