Project Title: 875 W. Orange Grove Ave. (TRACTMAP 13497-2020)

Project Location: 875 W. Orange Grove Ave., Pomona, Los Angeles County, CA

In 2014 the City of Pomona adopted a Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR), State Clearinghouse Number: 2012051025, which analyzed the environmental impacts of the City of Pomona's General Plan Update, Corridors Specific Plan, Active Transportation Plan, and Green Plan (hereafter collectively referred to as the GPU EIR). On March 3, 2014, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2014-26 certifying the GPU EIR as meeting the requirements of CEQA. Additionally, on March 3, 2014, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2014-27 approving General Plan Amendment (GPA) Number 13-007 to adopt the Pomona General Plan Update and approving the adoption of the Active Transportation Plan and the Green Plan as implementation tools of the General Plan Update.

According to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 (Projects Consistent with a Community Plan, General Plan, or Zoning), "projects which are consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site. This streamlines the review of such projects and reduces the need to prepare repetitive environmental studies." The applicant proposes the development of a 3.60-acre site with 33 three-story attached townhomes (9.2 dwelling units per acre), open space as well as associated on-site and off-site improvements. The project site is designated as General Plan Place Type Residential Neighborhood, which contemplates residential uses as well as Transect Zones T3 and T4-B, which each allow residential densities of up to 20 dwelling units per acre.

The Project includes an entitlement for a tentative tract map. A determination has been made that the project is consistent with the development density established by existing general plan policies for which an EIR was certified, and that no additional environmental review is required, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15183. The analyses conducted and the conclusions reached in the GPU EIR remain valid, and the project would not cause new significant impacts not identified in the Certified EIR. The proposed project is consistent with the City's General Plan; 1) the proposed project will not result in any peculiar impacts that were not identified as a significant impact under the 2014 General Plan Update EIR (GPU EIR); the project site has no value as habitat for endangered, rare or threatened species; 2) the proposed project will not have any significant effects upon the environment that were not identified as significant in the GPU EIR; 3) the proposed project will not result in a potentially significant offsite impact or cumulative impact not discussed in the GPU EIR; 4) the proposed project will not result in a more severe impact due to substantial new information that was not known at the time the GPU EIR; and the site can adequately be served by all required utilities and public services.

Pursuant California Code of Regulation 14, §753.5(e)(3), this Notice of Determination filing is not subject to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) environmental document fee. 14 CCR §753.5(e)(3) stipulates that only one fee is required when an existing certified EIR is used for multiple project approvals that would result in no additional effect to fish and wildlife. This Notice of Determination for the project approval described herein does not required the CDFW fee because the approval relies upon the GPU EIR (State Clearinghouse No. 2012051025).
