Notice is hereby given that the public agency named below has completed an Initial Study of the following described project at the following location: Northeast corner of Mojave Drive and Mesa Linda Avenue APN No. 3128-621-04

Project Description:	A Development Code Amendment to allow for public storage facilities to be listed as a conditionally permitted use in the M-1 (Light Industrial) Zone District; and a Site Plan and Conditional Use Permit to allow for the development of a self-service storage facility with recreational vehicle storage on undeveloped property zoned M-1 (Light Industrial).
