Project Title: Routine Maintenance at Existing Bridge and Culvert Facilities throughout Monterey, San Benito, and San Luis Obispo Counties (Streambed Alteration Agreement No.1600-2018-0062-R4).

Project Location: The Project will involve routine maintenance activities where numbered State Routes provide vehicular access over and along various named streams and unnamed tributaries, canals, and ditches throughout Caltrans District 5 (Monterey, San Benito, and San Luis Obispo Counties).

Project Description: The authorized Project Activities conditionally allowed under this Agreement involve routine and recurring work 1) to facilitate water conveyance through streams which exist along or cross under Caltrans maintained right-of-way; 2) to manage vegetation within lakes and streams which exist along or cross under Caltrans maintained right-of-way; and 3) constituting preventative maintenance of existing bridge and culvert facilities where streams cross under Caltrans maintained State Routes.
