Project Location - Specific: Dewatering discharges to occur along the San Diego Pipeline No. 5 to repair internal valves in the pipeline at station 1372+02 and the Red Mountain Pressure Control Structure, and conduct routine inspections and maintenance along the extent of the facilities (see attached location map).

Project Location - City: Fallbrook, unincorporated San Diego County **Project Location - County:** San Diego

Description of Project: Metropolitan proposes to dewater and shut down the San Diego Pipeline No. 5 to repair a valve at station 1372+02 within the pipeline and at the Red Mountain Pressure Control Facility, and conduct routine operation and maintenance activities as determined necessary following inspections along the extent of the facilities. The pipeline must be dewatered at various locations to allow MWD to perform the required repairs.

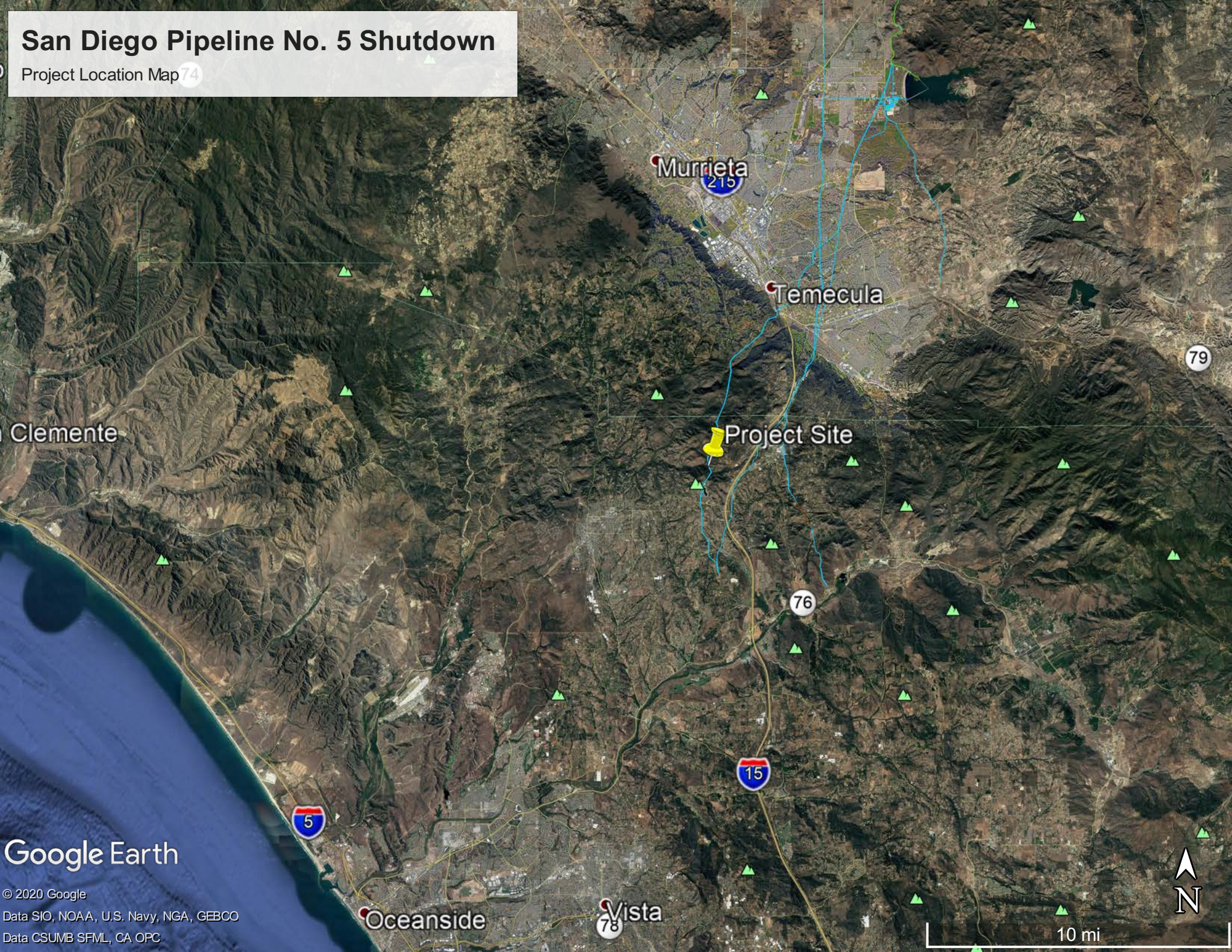
