**Project Location/City/County:** The proposed project is located on the right (north) bank levee of the American River, approximately 0.8 miles upstream of the CA Highway 160 bridge across the American River, in Sacramento County.

**Project Description:** Approval of Permit No.5365-2, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To remove and replace two (2) approximately 140 feet long 30-inch diameter welded steel pressurized pipes (WSP) with 30-inch diameter High-density polyethylene (HDPE) pipes; to remove and replace approximately 150 feet long 16-inch diameter WSP with 16-inch diameter HDPE pipe; to remove and replace approximately 150 feet long 42-inch diameter WSP with 42-inch diameter HDPE pipe; to remove and replace approximately 150 feet long 54-inch diameter WSP with 54-inch diameter HDPE pipe; and to install a new 6-inch diameter HDPE vault drainpipe with flapgate. Additional improvements include installing positive closure vault, repaving the waterside bike path and disturbed areas along the landside levee toe, and removing and replacing the existing fence near the landside levee toe at Sump 151.
