**Description:** 

Phased habitat restoration and enhancement over an approximate 5.8 acre project area. Wetland and upland habitat restoration activities include removal of fill to expand existing wetlands, marsh plain grading and channelization, restoration planting, seeding, irrigation and biological monitoring. Construction includes a new 1,050 ft. pedestrian nature trail on the northern boundary of the project made of pervious material and an

approximate 72 ft. long elevated boardwalk over the wetland.

The City Council of the City of Oceanside, as Lead Agency, considered and approved of the above described project on Wednesday, September 14, 2022 and determined that:

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and approved pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3. Mitigation Measures were established as conditions of approval and a Mitigation Monitoring Reporting Program was adopted.
- 4. A Statement of Overriding Consideration was not required nor adopted.

The Mitigated Negative Declaration and the record of project approval are available to the general public at the Development Services Department, Planning Division Counter, and 300 N. Coast , Highway, Oceanside, California.

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## **RESOLUTION** N0.22-R0636-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND ASSOCIATED MITIGATION MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR THE LOMA ALTA SLOUGH WETLANDS ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Loma Alta Slough Wetlands Enhancement Project was prepared and circulated Tor public and agency review and proper notification was given in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, and

WHEREAS. pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, and State Guidelines thereto; an initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration have been prepared stating that if the mitigation measures identified within the Initial Study are implemented there will not be an adverse impact upon the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Mitigated Negative Declaration together with any continents received, and Mitigation and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) incorporated by reference and appended in the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration, were presented to the City Council, and the City Council reviewed and considered the information contained in these documents prior to making a decision on the project; and

WHEREAS, the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) have been determined to be accurate and adequate documents, which reflect the independent judgment and analysis of the City Council. On the basis of the entire record before to, the City Council finds that there is no substantial evidence that the project. with implementation of the mitigation measures proposed, will have a significant impact on the environment; and

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WHEREAS, as required by Public Resources Code 2109! the City of Oceanside circulated the Mitigated Negative Declaration for public review and addressed all comments received within the review period, and

WHEREAS, studies and investigations made by this Council and in its behalf reveal the following facts:

## For the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration:

- I. The Final Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation and Monitoring and Reporting Program were completed in compliance with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- 2. There are certain potentially significant environmental impacts detailed in the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation and Monitoring and Reporting Program which have been avoided or substantially lessened by the establishment of measures which are detailed in Exhibit "A" Mitigation and Monitoring and Reporting Program.
- 3. The Final Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation and Monitoring and Reporting Program were presented to the City Council, and the City Council reviewed and considered the information contained in these documents prior to making a decision on the project. The Final Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation and Monitoring and Reporting Program have been determined to be accurate and adequate documents which reflect the independent judgment of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE. the City Council of the City of Oceanside does resolve as follows:

- I. The Final Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation and Monitoring and Reporting Program for the Loma Alta Wetlands Enhancement Project IS ADOPTED, effective as of this day.

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
