Project Title: Vallecitos Channel Maintenance Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-ALA-17926-R3)

Project Location (include county): Located off Vallecitos Road, north of San Antonio Reservoir in Alameda County.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-ALA-17926-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Kerri Smyth/Alameda County Water District

This project involves the following targeted treatment types and associated maintenance activities to repair erosion and stabilize the stream channel: vegetation and sediment management, bioengineering treatments, toe rock slope protection (RSP), full RSP, grouted RSP, and upland road drainage improvements.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project on 7/29/2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
