Project Title: Dog Bar Road Bridge Replacement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-NEV-30780-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at Bear River, in the Counties of Nevada and Placer, State of California; Latitude 39.062714, Longitude -121.002939; Assessor's Parcel Number: 027-140-005-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-NEV-30780-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Nevada County, Department of Public Works.

The Project involves the replacement of a two-way, one lane bridge connecting Nevada and Placer counties. The replacement bridge will have a broadened curve radius and will be built slightly upstream. Construction will include the use of temporary trestles and the dewatering and diversion of Bear River around the project site. The original bridge will be removed once construction is complete.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
