(Throughout most of the South East Sewer Collection System)

APN(s): This project occurs within the existing County Right of Way and existing sewer line foot print.

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: The project proposes to smoke test, line clean and replace sections of old and defective sewer lines throughout the South East Sewer Collection System managed by County of Lake, Special Utility Districts.

NAME OF PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT: Lake County Community Development

NAME OF PERSON OR AGENCY CARRYING OUT PROJECT: County of Lake – Special Districts Water and Waste Water Agency.

EXEMPT STATUS: Statutory Exemption Section 15269(a) and 15269(b)

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

Statutory Exemption 15269 Emergency Projects: 15269(a); projects to maintain, repair, restore, demolish, or replace facilities in a disaster stricken area in which a state of emergency has been proclaimed by the Governor AND 15269(b); emergency repairs to publicly owned service facilities necessary to maintain service essential to the public health, safety or welfare. Emergency repairs include those that require a reasonable amount of planning to address an anticipated emergency. Lake County has been besieged by wild fires in the last 5 years. Lake County Special Districts is acquiring grant funding to improve function of the existing sewer line to be better able to provide essential services and reduce occurrences of sewer spills as a result of inflow and infiltration during wet weather. By doing so, they will also reduce environmental risks and hazards and improve health and public safety.

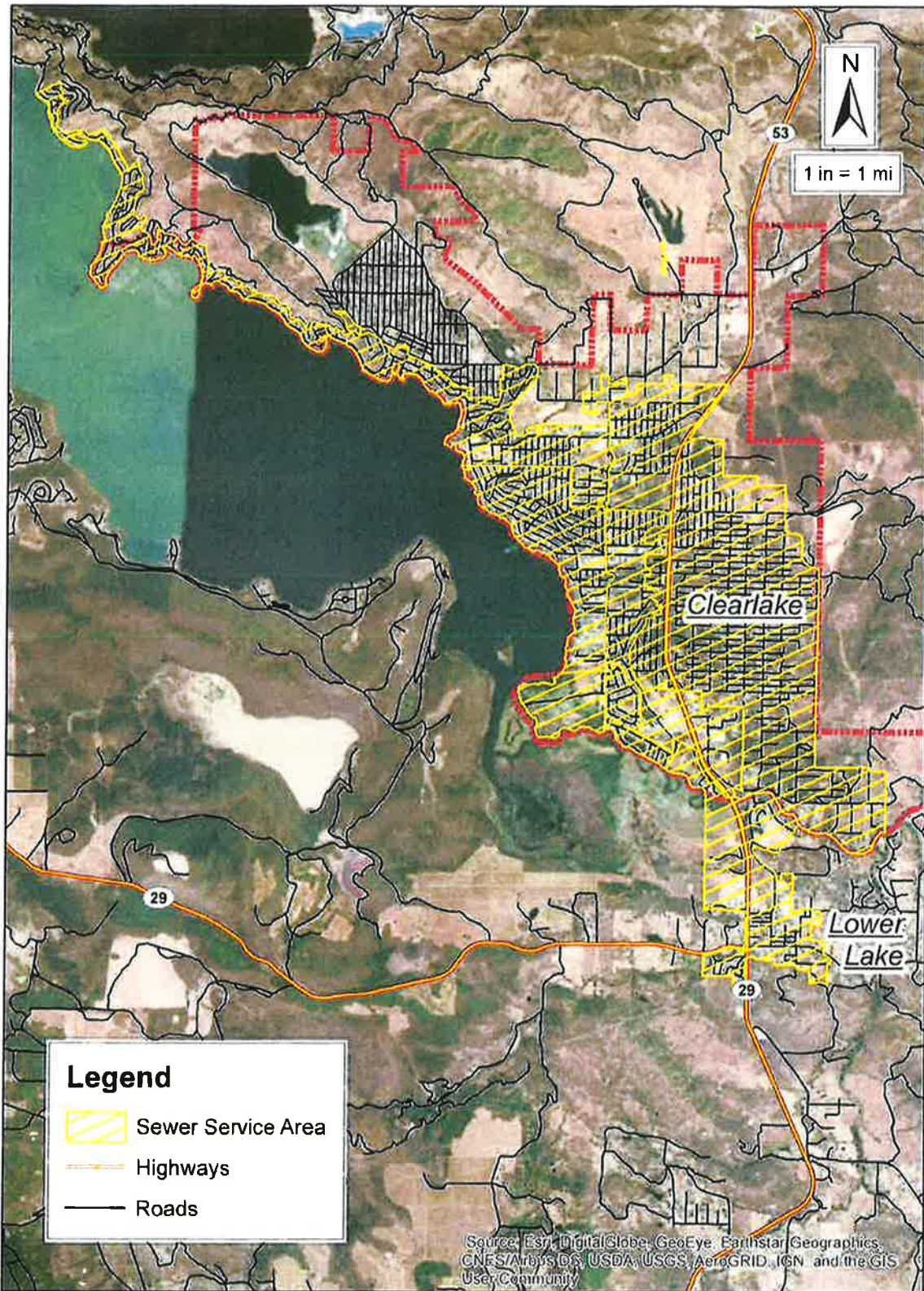

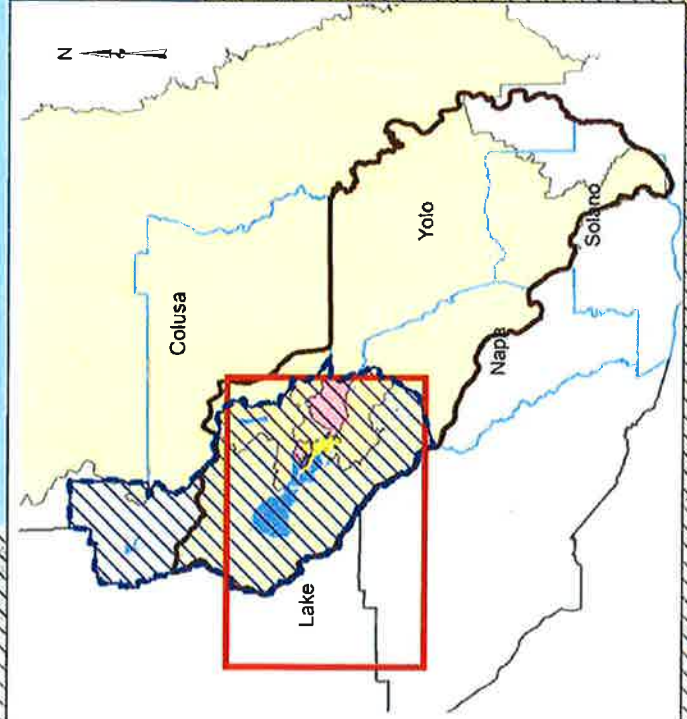
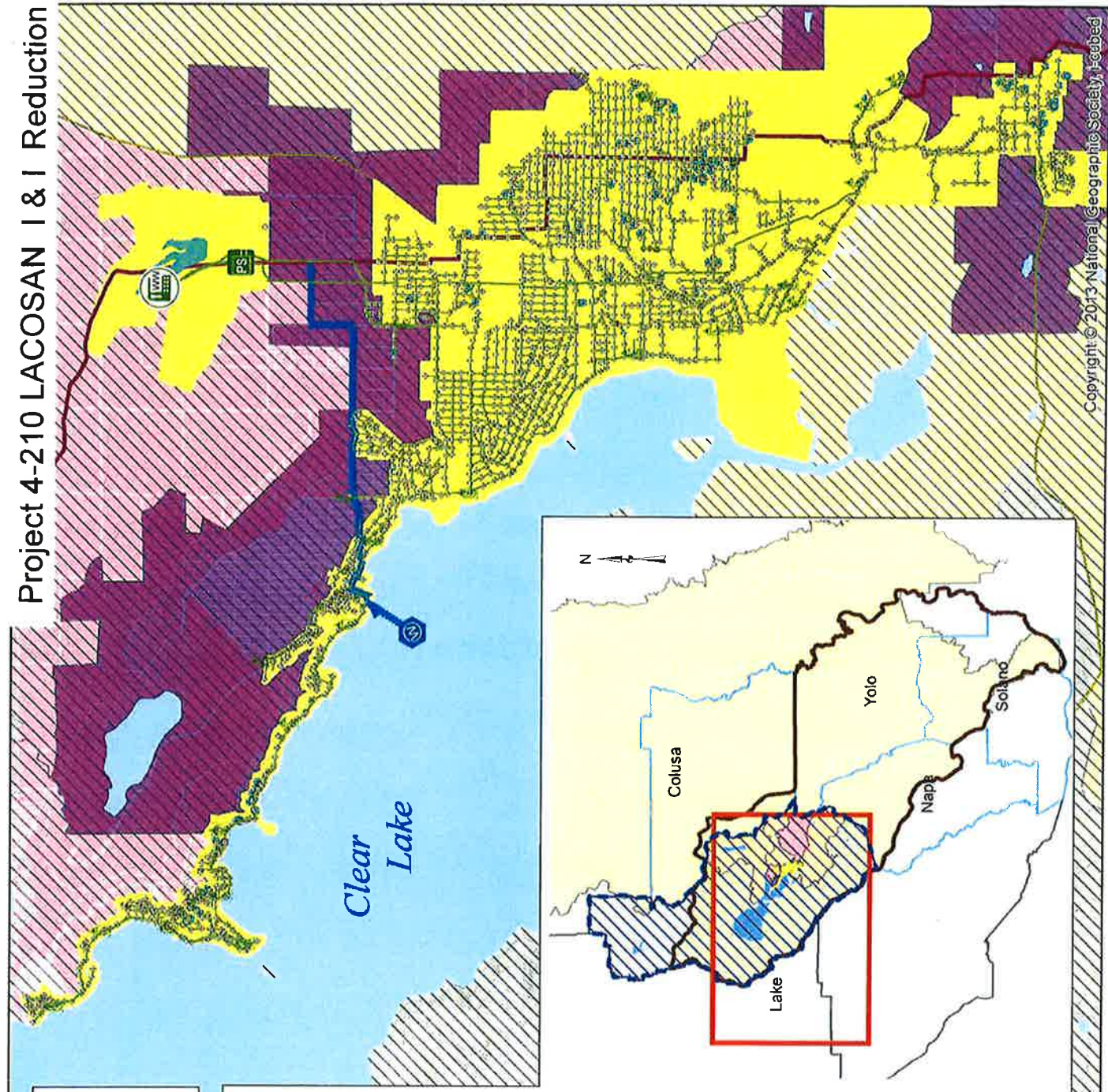


**LACOSAN I&I Reduction Project
