A Conditional Use Permit to install a new telecommunication facility consisting of a 82-foot tall faux monopine telecommunications tower, with 9 panel antennas, associated ground equipment, a 30kw backup diesel generator (with 54 gallon capacity tank) within a 625 square foot (25 x 25) lease area. Along with an access easement, drive, and underground utilities to the PG&E power supply along Brown's Valley Drive. The lease area is enclosed with a 6-foot chain link fence.

The parcel is located on the north side of Brown's Valley Drive, just northeast of Twin Oaks Drive and Brown's Valley Drive, at 13464 Brown's Valley Drive, north and east of Chico. APN: 016-220-019
