Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MON-35276-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of San Luis Obispo.

The Project includes activities related to the construction of a 13-foot wide paved driveway at six locations within unnamed tributaries to the Carmel River.
