The project is located in Section 4 Township 2 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian (<b>Figure 2 – USGS Map</b>).</p> <p>The project consists of wellhead treatment facilities at the sites of Well No. 13 and .17. Well No. 13 is located at 10987 Philadelphia Avenue and Well No. 17 is located at 3221 De Forest Circle (<b>Figure 3 – Aerial Map</b>), Jurupa Valley, CA.</p>
4.	(a) Project Location – City:	Jurupa Valley
	(b) Project Location – County:	Riverside
5.	Description of nature, purpose, and beneficiaries of Project:	<p>JCSD’s groundwater supply is from the Chino Basin. The Chino Basin is contaminated with per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). Since PFAS is toxic, water cannot directly be pumped from Well Nos. 13 and 17 and used as potable water without blending it with other water sources or treating it to remove PFAS. The purpose of this project is to install resin adsorption treatment systems at the existing well sites to remove PFAS from the groundwater pumped by Well Nos. 13 and 17.</p> <p>Improvements at Well Nos. 13 and 17 include the construction of concrete foundations for the treatment equipment, and water pipelines to connect the treatment equipment to existing JCSD water pipelines. The treatment system that will be installed at each well site consists of two (2) fil-trek filters, four (4) resin treatment vessels, and above and below ground piping</p>

	to connect the system components. The treatment vessels are 12-feet in diameter and, including the concrete foundation and piping above and below the tank, are approximately 16-feet tall. All project-related work will be done at the well sites. Since well sites are currently paved, no vegetation removal is required. The layout of the proposed treatment facilities are shown on <b>Figure 4 Well No. 13 Proposed Site Plan</b> and <b>Figure 5 – Well No. 17 Proposed Site Plan</b> .  Beneficiaries of the project are Jurupa Community Service District customers, which include residential and commercial uses.

Reason why project was exempt:	The project is categorically exempt from CEQA under the Class 1 exemption set forth in State CEQA Guidelines §15301, which exempts the "... operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. ... The key consideration is whether the project involves negligible or no expansion of use." CEQA Guidelines §15301(b) identifies "Existing facilities of both investor and publicly owned utilities used to provide electric power, natural gas, sewerage; or other public utility services."  Well No. 13 is fully equipped and currently operational. Well No. 17, although not currently in operation, is also fully equipped. The proposed water

	<p>treatment facilities will not result in an expansion of the existing use of Well No. 13 or the former use of Well No. 17. As such, the project is consistent with the categorical exemption set forth in State CEQA Guidelines §15301(b).</p> <p>Finally, none of the exceptions to the categorical exemptions apply here. The Project will not have any cumulative impacts; there is no reasonable possibility that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances; the Project does not affect any scenic highways or historical resources; and it is not located on a hazardous waste site.</p>
