Project Title: 6051 Ridge Road Remediation Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. LAK-10998-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at five (5) locations on an unnamed tributary to Highland Creek, in the County of Lake, State of California; Section 23, Township 13N, Range 10W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5 minute quad map Highland Springs, MDB&M.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has issued Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-10998 -R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Lake County Land Restoration Inc. as represented by Jed Morris.

The project is limited to the improvement of 3 existing culvert crossings, removal of water well drilling materials from a stream channel, and the removal of cannabis cultivation activities from a stream and recontouring and revegetation of the impacted area.
