DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: To install fee collection devices at existing campground dump stations to offset costs related to the proper disposal of RV dump wastes. All devices will be placed on existing concrete pads or on disturbed ground next to dump stations that lack significant biological or cultural resources.
