Project Title: Remediation of Pesticides in Oso Flaco Creek (Amendment to Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SLO-22575-R4)


Project Location: The Project is located in a 1.2 mile stretch of Oso Flaco Creek, approximately 2 miles southwest of the town of Nipomo, in southwest San Luis Obispo County, California; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 092-011-018, 092-391-019, 092-011-020, 092-021-025, 092-021-026, 092-021-027, and 092-021-028; USGS 7.5 Minute Quad Oceano MDBM; GPS Coordinates: from Latitude 35.01638 N, Longitude -120.58750 W, to Latitude 35.029586 N, Longitude -120.607286 W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SLO-22575-R4), issued to the Coastal San Luis Resource Conservation District. The Agreement authorizes activities related to on-farm sediment control in Oso Flaco Creek and removal of accumulated stream sediment. The Project amends the Agreement to remove the construction of a settling pond from the Agreement and add installation of two log structures in the stream.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 10/9/2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration and subsequent addendum prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Mitigated Negative Declaration and addendum prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
